2015 PALS Guidelines and Changes BLS: Agonal gasps are considered a sign of cardiac arrest. Check breathing and pulse simultaneously. Chest compressions at 100-120 per minute. (Compressions depth decreases as rate increases.) Chest compression depth 1/3-1/2 the AP diameter of the chest (~2 inches for children, ~1 1/2 inches for infant).
